Requirements and Responsibilities

1. Attend regularly scheduled meetings every month, beginning in August and ending in May, missing no more than two meetings in the academic year.

If a KREWE member learns that he/she will have to miss a meeting he/she is required to e-mail, call or text the house and/or president to obtain an “excused absence.”

2. Attend committee meetings on an as-needed basis.
3. Volunteer a minimum of 30 hours per academic year.
4. Represent Ronald McDonald House of Mobile as an “official Ambassador” at various community service events and fundraisers.
5. Raise visibility and awareness of RMH at his/her school.
6. Assume a leadership position each year by serving as an officer, a chair or a co-chair of one event/committee.
7. Serve on the committee of at least one other event.
8. Maintain **WEEKLY** contact with RMH Advisors through e-mail.
9. Have fun while helping our guests. If it ever is not fun, please let us know so that we may fix it.
